The New Mexico Office of the Attorney General, Medicaid Fraud Control Division, an Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) employer is seeking applicants for an “At Will” (not classified) Special Agent position. An “At Will” position means any state office job or position of employment which is exempt from the service and the Personnel Act, Section 10-9-4 NMSA 1978, and the employee serves at the pleasure of the New Mexico Attorney General. The following skills, experience and qualifications are preferred:

- Key tasks include the investigation of crimes, including Medicaid fraud as well as abuse, neglect, and exploitation of care facility residents. Successful applicants will possess experience in conducting complex, document intensive, long-term criminal investigations that result in successful prosecution.
- Applicant must have experience preparing comprehensive investigative reports, obtaining and serving subpoenas, writing and executing search warrants, securing and documenting evidence, and testifying in criminal proceedings. Applicants must have experience in conducting interviews of victims, witnesses, and suspects. Applicants must also be able to participate in surveillance and undercover operations.
- Applicant must have the ability to work independently as well as in a multi-disciplinary team, including: auditors, information technology specialists, legal staff, medical care investigators, prosecutors, and law enforcement agents. Applicant must also possess the ability to collaborate with other state, local and federal partners in the law enforcement, regulatory, and treatment arenas.
- Applicant must possess a New Mexico law enforcement officer certification or have the ability to obtain certification by waiver of previous training course.
- Spanish-speaker preferred.

Salary range is \$65,000-\$68,000, and is commensurate with experience. Resume, writing sample, and three professional references must be received at the Office of the Attorney General. The position will remain open until filled. Applicants selected for an interview must notify the Office of the Attorney General of the need for a reasonable accommodation due to a Disability.
